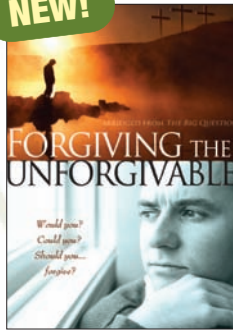


Forgiving the Unforgivable

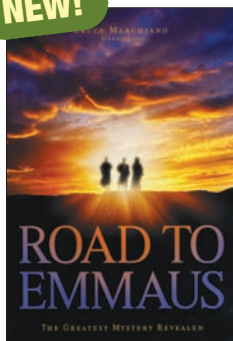


Road to Emmaus

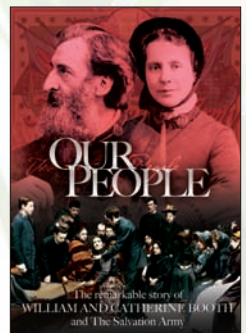

Matt Kern went from being an "A" student to flunking out. One night in 1988, he and two friends decided to steal a car but in a moment's haste, one of the friends shot and killed the driver. His prison schemes landed him in 13 months of Solitary Confinement. Only then did he begin to experience guilt. 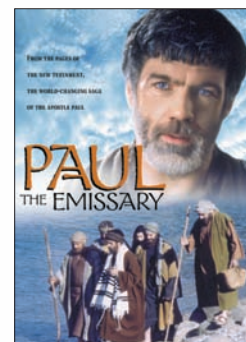

A simple God-seeking man, William Tyndale somehow became one of the most wanted men in England and all of Europe.
