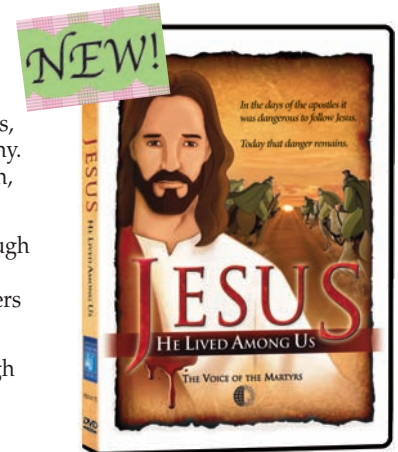
Jesus: He Lived Among Us
